Orchard Road, 8-17 Sep

This dynamic visual experience will take visitors on an adventure that captures the essence of the race season and the vibrancy of our city. Over at Wisma Atria, sportscar lovers can also get up close and personal with the Alpine A110 at the **Motor Showcase: Alpine x AMOS ANANDA Sports Car Display** wrapped in a race-themed design by local streetwear designer, Amos Ananda. Shoppers will be spoilt for choice at **Orchard Pit Shops: GPSS Lifestyle Bazaar**, a lifestyle bazaar with stalls serving artisanal products and unique retail experiences in an eclectic festival atmosphere with heart-thumping tunes and a photo-opportunity at every turn.

Singapore's most vibrant entertainment lifestyle hub comes alive from day to night. **GPSS Fitness Fest** feat. **Les Mills** kicks off on the first weekend of the precinct party as fitness buffs challenge their horsepower with high-intensity workout routines. At the **Teleios Race Sims Grand Slam**, motorsports enthusiasts experience the adrenaline of race season as they commandeer state-of-the-art racing simulators in a gripping competition to claim the GPSS Sims Championship title. Racing fans can get a chance to see their favourite drivers in action at **OutDrive GP**, where the likes of Nico Hülkenberg, Pietro Fittipaldi, Brad Benavides and more will go head-to-head against top local sim racing drivers in the Teleios Racing



Simulators.
