EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR STATISTICS ON INTERNATIONAL VISITOR ARRIVALS

Source of Data

Visitors arriving in Singapore are required to complete prescribed disembarkation/embarkation cards which serve as the source of statistics on visitor arrivals and departures. The accuracy of figures pertaining to the characteristics of visitors therefore depends on how accurately visitors complete these cards.

Definitions

International visitor arrivals

All visitors are classified by country of residence unless otherwise stated. Total international visitor arrivals include all visitors coming by air and sea and non-Malaysian citizens coming by land.

Visitor days

Visitor Days is the total number of days that international visitors stay in a country outside of their country of residence, whose main purpose of visit is other than the exercise of an activity remunerated from within the country visited.

Visitor days

= International visitors arrivals X average length of stay.
